Being encapsulated under the safety glass surface, colours are UV stable and do not fade. By combining Chromatics with leading edge digital printing techniques, an infinite range of ex-

isting graphics is possible too, including the printed replication of any traditional finishes such as natural stone, wood, terracotta, porcelain, marble, ceramic, brick and metal surfaces.

Whereas conventional toughened ceramic-coated glass has to be made to size, Chromatics is a stockable product that can be cut and edge-worked, even after processing – and assembled to suit any glazing system. Potentially, this can save weeks, or even months, when closing the building envelope and can certainly save on costs.

Chromatics is a UK manufactured product and the production process is a low-energy green technology using float glass and organic colour pigments. The product is entirely free from toxic elements, solvent-based compounds and heavy metals such as lead and cadmium – even when supplying traditionally 'difficult' colours such as reds, violets and purples. This discreet product can cope with a load of up to 600kg and door leafs of up to three metres high. The Circo C90 SU is totally silent and offers fully powered automatic movements without hydraulics or spring components. Openings can be from 90° to 250° and is also available in a push and go and also low energy version. Safety is a key priority in any building design these days and the Circo C90 SU conforms to BS7036 and can be connected to a buildings smoke/fire alarm system and also

building management systems. It operates from a conventional power supply (240v) or 110v if required. The opening time and speed of operation are continuously adjusted thanks to a computerised system. Electronic control is via a four function operating switch (80x80mm). The Circo C90 SU Swing Door Operator fits underneath the floor within a very high quality stainless steel frame and is then hermetically sealed with a stainless steel cover plate.
